If the owner of the motor vehicles specified in fails to get the permit renewed or countersigned by the due date, he shall be liable to pay the following late fee in addition to the fee payable namely :-

FOR LIGHT MOTOR VEHICLES

- (1) Delay upto 15 days Rs 10/-per day
- (2) Delay from 16th days to 30 days Rs 15/- per day
- (3) Delay from 31st day onward Rs 20/- per day

FOR HEAVY MOTOR VEHICLES

- (1) Delay upto 15 days Rs 15/- per day
- (2) Delay from 16th days to 30 days Rs 20/- per day
- (3) Delay from 31st day onward Rs 25/- per day.

Provided that the late fee so charged shall not exceed double the amount of renewal fees/countersignature fee due from such owner. In case the owner does not get the permit renewed/countersigned within a period of three months, the competent authority shall initiate necessary action under th provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988/ Central Motor Vehicles Rules,1989 against the permit holder.

Note 1: For the removal of doubts, it is hereby clarified that medium passenger motor vehicles, heavy goods vehicles, imported motor vehicles or any other vehicles not mentioned against Serial No.4 of the above Table include both transport and non-transport vehicles.

Note 2: Where the certificate of registration issued is in the form of any Smart Card Type, an additional fee of rupees two hundred shall be charged except in the case of issue of fresh certificate of registration after cancellation of hire purchase or lease or hypothecation agreement.

Pollution Check Centre

Security and Fee for authorization of agency and issue of pollution under control certificate:-

The following Security and fee for authorization of issuing a pollution under control certificate under rule 115(7) of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 shall be payable by the agency applying for such authorization, namely :-

Security refundable to be deposited with the Director of Transport. Rs. 15000/- for centers located in urban areas and Rs 5000/- for centers located in rural areas.

Provided that the agencies already authorized shall deposit refundable security at the time of renewal of authorization:

Provided further that a non-refundable application fee of Rs. 500/- shall be charged from the agency/applicant applying for Pollution Under Control authorization;

Provided that registration marks specified against Sr. No. 1 shall be reserved for the motor vehicles owned by the Government and shall be allotted only after the payment of fixed charge of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs One lac only) by the concerned Government Agency:

Provided further that the registration marks specified against Sr. No. 2,3 and 4 shall be totally paid numbers and shall be allotted on first come first serve basis:

Provided further that in case of any motor vehicle meets with an accident and is a total loss duly certified by the Insurance Company, the owner of the said motor vehicle shall not be required to pay the special registration fee specified for the same registration number for a new vehicle in the same name in whose name the earlier vehicle was registered:

Provided further that the owner may retain the registration mark of his vehicle, after the sale or scrapping of such old vehicle only when the same is re-assigned a new registration mark by the Registering and Licensing Authority. The primary number, if vacated, shall remain in safe custody of the Registering and Licensing Authority and the previous owner shall be entitled to get the same registration mark assigned to his new vehicle within a period of one year from the date of such surrender. For assigning the said registration mark to the new vehicle, no special registration fee shall be charged from the such previous owner. In case the such previous owner of vehicle fails to get the same number assigned to a new vehicle within a period of one year, the said number shall be deemed to have been surrendered to the Government and the concerned Registering and Licensing Authority shall be at liberty to assign that number to any other applicant in accordance with the provisions of these rules."
